

Summer Camp

Registration Check List

- ◆ Registration begins at 12 noon each Sunday.
No individual or group will begin the registration process before 12 noon.
However your group may begin to form a line for registration upon arrival.
- ◆ The first meal camp serves is dinner. Approximately 4:30pm
Please make sure that all of your students eat a healthy lunch before arriving at camp.

Before your students get in line they should....

- ◆ Locate and have in hand their complete medical form *including immunization records*- unless they previously mailed them to Oswegatchie.
- ◆ Locate and have in hand all medications. *ALL* medications must be handed in to the medical director at registration.
- ◆ Locate and have in hand all money that they wish to deposit into their camp store accounts. Store accounts allow students to spend money at the camp store without having to carry cash. Any money that they do not spend will be returned to them in cash on Friday.
- ◆ Students should have quick access to their swim suit and towel!
After the first part of registration they will head directly to the beach for their swim test. Students are required to take and pass the swim test if they wish to participate in swimming and boating during there week of camp.

Seaplane: If you have students who wish to ride the seaplane they must have the seaplane permission slip *signed by their parents!* This form is part of the summer camper registration form. If the student wishes to ride the seaplane they must pay an addition fee for this service. If they did not take care of seaplane permission and payment in advance they must do it when they travel through the registration line.

Payment for campers will be excepted at registration. Cash or check only.

Teachers should come through the registration line if they need lodging at Oswegatchie for the week. We also need to count the teachers in attendance for the week so that we can give the kitchen an accurate head count for meals.
